That's why this book was born.

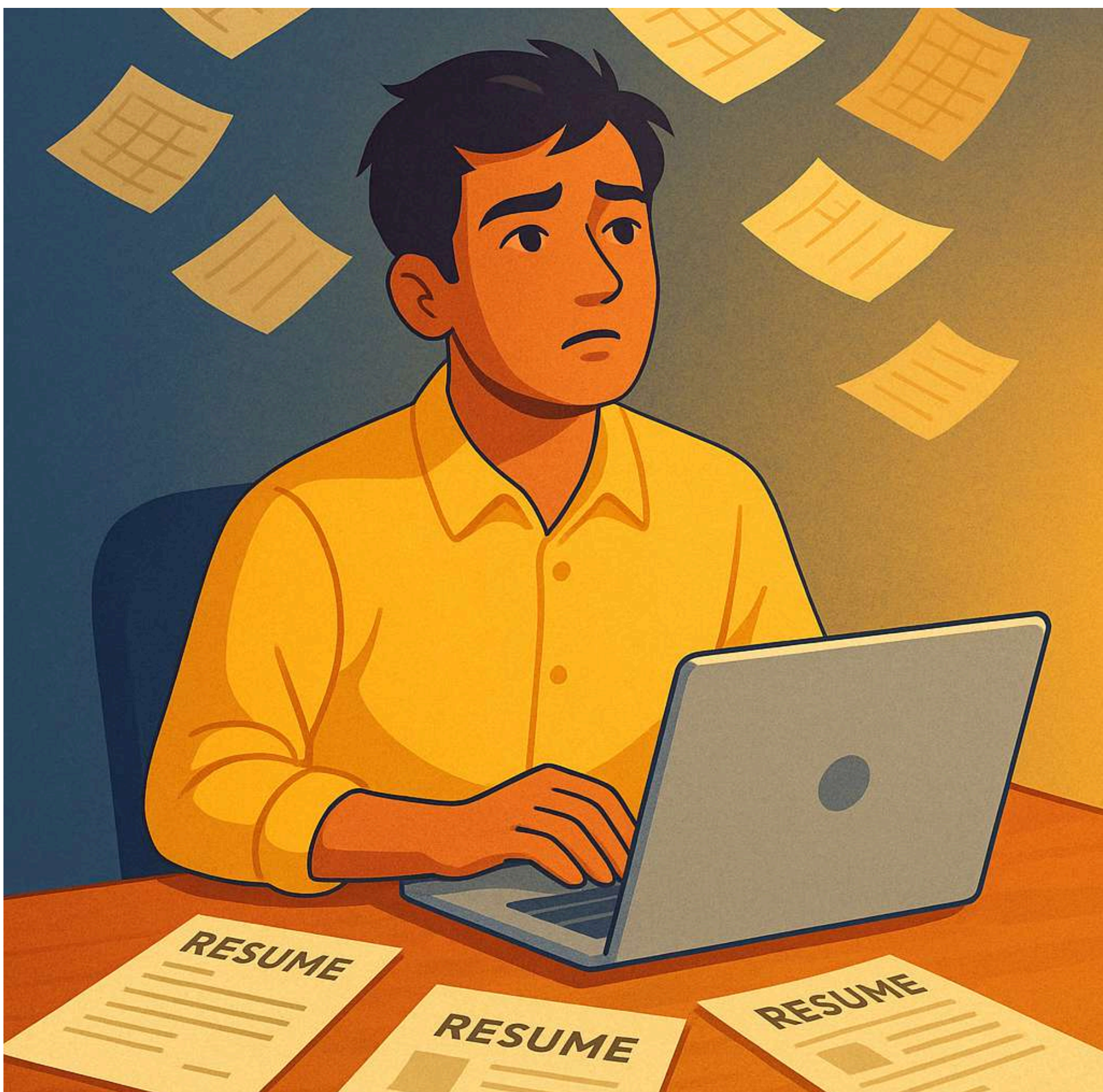
It's not theory. It's not motivation. It's a **toolkit of 30 field-tested hacks**, built from real conversations, career experiences, and hundreds of fresher success stories.
